



Together for a better Skurup

Skurup should be a safe municipality characterised by optimism for the future and a sense of community. Here, you should be able to live a good life, whether you live in Abbekås, Rydsgård, Slimminge, Skivarp and Skurup or in the countryside.

We put welfare first. Schools should inspire a love of learning. Older people should receive reliable care. Everyone should be able to afford a place to live and a decent standard of living.

We are building a Skurup where no one is left behind.

Health and social care with security and quality

Everyone should feel secure throughout their lives. You should be able to continue living at home for as long as you wish and are able to, and when you need support, help should be available.

The number of older people in Skurup is rising sharply. That is why the council needs to expand care services for older people in good time.

We want to:

- Develop sheltered housing and care homes in line with demand.
- More time, security and influence for those who need care and support.
- Offer daily activities tailored to different needs.
- Develop a senior citizens' centre at Rutgerskolan to foster a sense of community and improve health.
- Create local meeting places to prevent isolation and involuntary loneliness among older people.

We want to attract dedicated staff who enjoy their work and stay with us for the long term. Skurup Municipality should be the obvious choice for those working in the care sector.

We want to:

- Ensure adequate staffing levels and more permanent posts, with the option of full-time work.
- Introduce a reduction in working hours for care staff.
- Give care staff greater say over their timetables.
- Put an end to unwanted split working shifts.
- Provide work shoes.



Skurup Municipality should be an attractive employer for care staff.

A school where every child can succeed

No pupil or teacher should go to school feeling anxious. Skurup should have safe schools with enough staff.

Skurup can afford better kindergartens and schools. We are now prioritising this.

We want to:

- Develop gymnasium education with academic programmes
- Employ more teachers, teaching assistants and staff in schools
- Introduce free train and bus passes for school pupils throughout the school terms.
- Strengthen pupil welfare with more special needs teachers and counsellors.
- Keep schools open throughout the municipality.
- Provide every school with a proper library staffed by a librarian.
- Give all pupils at least one cultural experience per term
- Reintroduce childcare during non-standard working hours.
- Introduce a maximum limit on group sizes in kindergartens.

We say no to religious independent schools and profit-driven school companies.

A safe Skurup for everyone

You should feel safe in your everyday life. Anxiety and violence should primarily be addressed through preventive work, not through suspiciousness.

We want to:

- Continue to strengthen cooperation between schools, social services and the police.
- Invest more in youth centres (fritidsgård) and meeting places for everyone.
- Increase the number of staff on the ground by providing more resources to social services.
- Provide better support for those subjected to violence or honour-based oppression.
- Make it easier for municipal staff to serve as part-time firefighters.
- Improve safety in home care services, for both staff and service users.
- Strengthen support for people with mental health issues and disabilities.

Climate, environment and sustainable infrastructure

Skurup must take responsibility for the climate whilst becoming a better municipality to live in.



We want to:

- Use more solar energy, biogas and other renewable energy sources.
- Preserve the municipality's own water sources and secure reserve water supplies.
- Protect land around watercourses and enhance biodiversity.
- Create more municipal nature reserves close to where you live.
- Plant more trees and install green roofs.
- Ensure that any future expansion of the quarry in Beden does not harm the environment and that adequate road safety measures are in place.
- Develop Nils Holgersson Gymnasium into a centre for sustainable agriculture and organic farming.

We say no to nuclear power in the municipality.

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Better traffic and effective public transport

It should be possible to live anywhere in the municipality without being dependent on a car.

We want to:

- Improve public transport within and to Skurup Municipality, with double-track rail lines and more bus routes.
- Ensure the municipality has greater insight into and the ability to improve the quality of the transport service for people with disabilities. Ensure the ring road around Skurup town is completed.
- Build more cycle paths between the built-up areas.
- Improve road safety at the slip roads to the E65.
- Make it easier for people with pushchairs, walking frames or wheelchairs to get around the municipality.
- Provide more charging points for electric vehicles in Skurup Municipality.
- Introduce a bike-share system in the municipality.

Jobs, businesses and local development

Skurup should be a municipality where people can work, run businesses and thrive.

We want to:

- Help more people into work.
- Provide better support for small businesses and the local business community.
- Prioritise local businesses and locally produced goods in purchasing and procurement.



- Require fair terms and conditions in line with collective agreements in municipal procurement.
- Offer career and vocational guidance to more residents.
- The municipality should support destination development for the tourism industry in Skurup.

Culture, recreation and community

Culture and recreation enriches life and fosters a sense of community.

We want to:

- Build a cultural centre in central Skurup.
- Create more accessible meeting places and activities for all ages throughout the municipality.
- Introduce a free arts and culture school.
- Offer free swimming lessons.
- Develop 'The Wonderful World of Nils Holgersson' as a visitor and tourist destination for Skurup.
- Introduce a recreation bank where people can borrow sports and leisure equipment for free.

More affordable housing

Everyone has the right to decent housing.

We want to:

- Build more rental properties through Skurupshem.
- Keep rents down.
- Ensure there is housing for young people, older people and families with children.
- Build sustainably and protect valuable farmland.

Skurup can afford to invest. The council is running a large surplus, whilst schools, culture and welfare services lack resources. We believe the money should be spent where it does the most good – for children, older people, staff, local businesses and the future.
